## Proficiency

Courses in German and English

The language of instruction at TU Braunschweig is German. Some study courses offer classes in English. Research and thesis work can usually be done in English.

German language knowledge

As an exchange student, you do not need to take a language test to be accepted at TU Braunschweig. However, we strongly recommend a fair command of German in order for you to successfully study and live in Braunschweig. Should you select English classes, you obviously need to have a working command of English.

Should you wish to improve your German skills, the Language Centre at TU Braunschweig offers summer courses and German classes during the semester on all levels.

**Insurance policies**

All students studying at TU Braunschweig require adequate health and liability insurance. Proof of this has to be presented when you enrol for your courses. Without sufficient insurance cover you cannot be enrolled at TU Braunschweig!

The simplest option is to take out German insurance policies. If you intend to rely on insurance policies taken out with providers in your home country, ensure that these are valid in Germany and that they offer the same cover as their equivalent here.

To make your start in Braunschweig easy, we can find a buddy for you.

Your peer student knows Braunschweig and the university and will:pick you up from Braunschweig train station and show you your accommodation

assist you with the first steps in Braunschweig, such as enrolling, opening a bank account, visiting the Foreigners' Registration Office or getting a library card assist you with all initial difficulties you may face. show you around the university and the city, so you can find your way around easily and settle in quickly.
