Courses may be taken in most of the colleges pending seat availability and pre-requisites, **(except courses in Digital Media and Journalism (DMJ), which are restricted).**

Number of credits per course	3 - 4 credits per course unless otherwise indicated (some classes may be only 1 credit).
Credit load per semester	Undergrad: 12-18 credits (4 - 6 classes).
Course Selection	Must be submitted through the online application prior to arrival on campus. Changes can be made during the first week of the semester, subject to availability.
Minimum workload per semester	12 credits to stay in compliance with immigration regulations (example: three 4-credit classes).
Contact hours per course	<p>Lectures and Seminars: 1 credit corresponds to a minimum of 50 class minutes per week plus a minimum of 100 prep minutes per week, for 15 weeks. Laboratory: 1 credit corresponds to a minimum of 100 contact minutes per week plus a minimum of 50 prep minutes per week, for 15 weeks.</p> <p>For more detailed information: https://www.newpaltz.edu/media/academic-affairs/suny_new_paltz_credit_hour_policy-final_5-23-16.pdf</p>
Teaching Methods	Lecture and Seminar. This will include, reading assignments, in-class discussions, presentations, group and/or individual projects.
Medical Coverage	<p>All international students at New Paltz are automatically enrolled in the SUNY International Student Health Insurance, which meets the requirements of the J-1 visa regulations. This health insurance is mandatory and cannot be waived.</p> <p>Students will receive their policy information and insurance card via email from the insurance company. In addition, students will be notified when their insurance card can be picked up from the International Student Office.</p>
Housing	<p>It is strongly recommended that exchange students live-on campus in our Residence Halls during their time here https://www.newpaltz.edu/reslife/</p> <p>The university is not involved with off-campus housing</p>
